

# 2021 BLUE EARTH COUNTY FAIR SUMMER SLAM

## Demo Derby Rules and Regulations

### Kid and Guardian 2 Person Stock Compact Rules

*Any 4 or 6 Cylinder FWD EXCEPT Pre-79 El Dorado, Toronado, ETC. RWD Cars must be 108" or less wheelbase*

*Kid must be between 10-14 years of age and must be with legal guardian.*

1. All doors may be fastened shut in 3 spots per seam by #9 wire or 3/8" chain. Driver's door may be welded solid and re-enforced for driver's safety. You must add metal to the outside of the driver's door and passenger door up to 6" past the front and rear door seam for protection. Both driver and passenger door must be contrasting colors from the rest of the car.
2. You may use bumper of choice. Bumpers may be old iron, 80's, or a manufactured bumper. Manufactured bumpers may be up to 4" x 4" tubing with a 4" point. When mounting bumper you may collapse OEM shock from your car into frame or hardnose bumper on with no added material.
3. Cutting of fenders for tire clearance is allowed, no bolting or welding of fenders.
4. Tucking the trunk lid is allowed, you may fasten trunk shut in 4 locations with #9 wire or 3/8 chain. You may not body shape the trunk or any other panel in any way, this is a stock build.
5. Hoods may be fastened in 6 locations. You may use up to 3/4" bolts sheet metal to sheet metal, #9 wire, or 3/8 chain. These 6 locations must not connect together. Hood must have a hole cut in case of fire, hood openings may have up to (4) 3/8" bolts per opening or 8 3/8" bolts total.
6. Engines may be wired, chained, or welded in 2 locations and can go around the frame one loop only, if welding do not do in a way that re-enforces the frame (3" piece max, straight up and down, not used as a kicker). No engine protectors will be allowed. You cannot re-enforce motor mounts, no header protectors or carburetor protector will be allowed.
7. Stock axles with no bracing or modifying of brackets... all 4WD or AWD must be disabled.
8. Body mounts, suspension, and shocks must be stock only, no re-enforcing the strut.
9. Transmission Coolers are allowed, you may alter the transmission linkage, modify your ignition, headers allowed. Must have working brakes that will be checked before entering the track. Can be ran be either side but must have emergency brake pedal on passenger side for guardian to control if need be.
10. Any tire allowed, stuffed ok, stem protectors allowed. Wheel weights must be removed! You may add an outer flap (extra sidewall) to the outer side for protection. You may screw or glue beads to rims.
11. Fuel tanks should be removed and located in the back seat area securely fastened and covered with a non-flammable material. If the fuel tank is in front of the rear axle you may run in stock location at the official's discretion. If this becomes a safety issue you will be disqualified! If running an electric fuel pump you must have a shut off clearly marked.
12. One battery allowed and it must be moved to the passenger side front floorboard and covered with a non-flammable item.
13. Safety bars in or on top of the dash and behind the seat are MANDATORY with a max 8" x 8" mounting plate. All cage material can be a max of 4" diameter. You may run side bars from the front to rear bar. You may run a roll-bar but it can only be attached to the seat bar only, no cage material may go to the floor. All cage material can be no further rearward than the most forward side of the rear wheel well tubs.
14. You must run 2 front windshield bars for safety. These bars may be up to 2" max diameter and attach from the cowl to the roof. The attachment point may be welded or bolted, no more than a 5" square. You may also have a driver's door and passenger door window netting. No rear window bars allowed, no wire in any other window openings, no wire from roof to any location other than specified.
15. Stock cooling systems only.
16. Pre run cars will be allowed up to (6) 4"x6"-1/4" thick plates. If bringing a pre run that needs plates contact me first. I want proof of the bend!
17. If the rules do not say you can do it, don't! Officials decision is final.
